Q: WHAT ARE FAMILY SUCCESS TEAM (FST) MEETINGS?

A: A strength based support group that offers resources to families seeking a positive change in their lives. A collaboration of community agencies offer support, information and resources to assist families in need. (Candidates for this program must meet certain criteria to qualify for service)

Q: WHY ARE FST MEETINGS SO IMPORTANT?

A: Since its inception, May 2006, these meetings have changed the lives several individual's and their families. With the assistance of the professional team members, families have made positive changes in their lives, from feeling hopeless and powerless to feeling empowered and becoming self sufficient. Our constant goal is to reach out to more of those in our community, and provide additional professional resources for families in need.

Q: WHO IS A CURRENT PROFESSIONAL TEAM MEMBER?

A: Current team members include representatives of the Women's Center of Tracy, Family Resource and Referral, Sutter Tracy Healthy Connections Resource Center, Child Protective Services of San Joaquin, San Joaquin County WorkNet, and the Pregnancy Resource Center of Tracy. We regularly seek involvement of agencies that will be specifically beneficial to the family.

Q: WHERE ARE THESE MEETINGS HELD?

A: Meetings are held at the Sutter Tracy Healthy Connections Resource Center Classroom located at 35 E. 10th Street, Tracy. This site offers a comfortable, confidential environment for all those present.

Q: WHEN ARE THESE MEETINGS HELD?

A: Every Tuesday, the professional team gathers prior to meeting the client to discuss the progress and plan for the candidate. The length of the meeting varies depending on the individual's list of needs and participation..
